### **Application Entry Deadline April 1, 2023 (additional fee \$50 after 4-1-23)**

Welcome to the SPRING JAMBOREE. This outdoor festival is held in Glorious Clean Green Boulder City near City Hall in Bicentennial Park, Wilbur Square and Escalante Parks. This event is the major fundraising event for the Boulder City Chamber of Commerce and is filled with arts, crafts, antiques, music, pageantry, song, dance, classic cars and local businesses. This year will prove to be another weekend full of fun and laughter along with spectacular arts and crafts. And we must not forget the wonderful food we enjoy during any affair in the park.

#### **Booth Options (all booth spaces in each park are 15 x 10):**

**Handmade Arts and Crafts** are the flagship vendors at Spring Jamboree and are given priority placement and highlighted at this Festival. The lovely Wilbur Square is reserved for their talents and wares. This area is very shady, flat and green with easy access for load-in and out. All items for sale must be at least 51% handmade to be in this section. Example: purchased clothing must have hand-painted embellishments to qualify. Although this is not a juried show, the Show Committee will review all applications to make sure the correct booth option and category has been selected. You will be notified immediately if there is a problem with your application. Your booth assignment and maps will be sent by the first week of April. There will be judging and ribbons awarded to the winners in the handmade section. Judges will be looking for originality, excellence, design, creativity and craftsmanship. Only artists and craftsmen displaying their own original work will be eligible to be judged in the competition. If you are a new artist this year, please submit 2 pictures with your application—one of your product, and one of your booth setup for review. Please label the back of your photos with your name and business name. They will be returned to you with your gift bag at the Festival. Only one artist per booth will be accepted. Load-in is Friday at 6am and load-out is Sunday at 4pm.

**Commercial Vendors** are accepted at this event and will be part of the Chamber Showcase area featuring our supportive Chamber Member Businesses. The Bicentennial Park is reserved for these businesses and is near the main stage and performing area. Pre-packaged food is accepted and a copy of your Health District permit for sampling is required 10 days prior to the show date. Only one vendor per booth will be accepted. Load-in is Friday at 6am and load-out is Sunday at 4pm. No exclusivity is promised and we will not police competing booths. Handmade artists that request to be placed in this area will need to apply and pay at the commercial rate.

**Antiques In The Park** is a wonderful addition to the Spring Jamboree line-up of booth options. It too is a very shady area in South Escalante Park and is particularly an easy park for loading/unloading heavy furniture and larger items. There is no vendor parking in the spaces adjacent to the park, unless pre-arranged with the Show Producer. Only one vendor per booth will be accepted. Antiques set up begins at 9am on Friday and a Show Volunteer will be in your area.

**Chamber Showcase~Member Vendors** have the option to choose any of the booth selections, based on your category, at a reduced rate. You must be a member in good standing at the time you submit your application.

#### **Display:**

Exhibitors must provide their own booth set up and displays. Displays must be professional and neat in appearance. Each display must be set up and ready for guests by 8:30am both days. Displays must remain set up until 4:00pm on Sunday. Those not complying with this will not be permitted in future Boulder City shows. Live demonstrations are encouraged. Please let us know if you will be doing demos so that we can advertise this for you. **GENERATORS AND TENT STAKES ARE NOT PERMITTED.** Limited electrical power is available. Please contact the Chamber Office to see if this option is still available at the time of your application.

### **General Information:**

The Spring Jam volunteer committee will be reviewing all applications as they come in and will immediately notify the applicant if there are any questions or concerns. In extreme cases where an application denial is required, an immediate refund will be issued and returned to the applicant. The "Check-In/Information" booth will be clearly marked with flags and is located in Bicentennial Park. It will be open at 6:00am on Friday. You will not need to check-in prior to setting up as your space number and maps will be included in your April Packet mailed to the address provided. However, if you have any questions, someone will be at the Information booth. This same booth will become the "Check-out/Sales Tax Collection" booth at 4pm on Sunday.

Your booth fee must be included with this application. The fee does **include** a \$25 non-refundable application fee. Please make checks out to Boulder City Chamber of Commerce. You can call the office with your credit card information, if you choose. If you cancel prior to April 1st, your fee minus the \$25 will be returned to you. Any cancellations after April 1st are not refundable and there are NO exceptions. All monies are committed at the time they are received to the promotion and presentation of this Festival. Returned checks result in an automatic disqualification of your application. There are no exceptions and your future ability to return to any Boulder City shows will be jeopardized. Participation in previous Boulder City festivals does not guarantee acceptance from year to year. No refunds for inclement weather or for non-compliance of Festival rules and regulations. All space fees include a \$10 per day fee paid to the City of Boulder City for your Temporary Boulder City Business License.

Exhibitors are responsible for the safety and liability of their own displays and product. You are responsible for the security of your work. The Chamber, volunteers and staff can not assume any responsibility for any loss or damage to any inventory, artistic works, display materials, or artist's personal property for any cause whatsoever during the course of the event. Spring Jamboree can not be held responsible for any fraudulent transactions accepted during the event. Security will be provided by volunteer workers and a paid security company on Friday and Saturday from 6pm to 6am.

Exhibitors are responsible for loading and unloading their own displays and product. The use of event golf carts are no longer available to exhibitors. Please make sure to have prearrangements if your items are oversized. Bringing your own wagons, carts, dollies, etc are extremely encouraged for those that may need assistance.

Exhibitors are prohibited from distributing literature or promotional materials including, but not limited to, religious, fraternal, political or commercial organizations. Literature on the artist's/craftmen's work, shop or gallery is permitted.

No mechanically reproduced sound or music can be played without previous consent from producer. Your assigned booth number must be displayed at all times and the back emergency information completed. Booth space must be clean before leaving the park at the end of the show or a fine of \$25 will be assessed and future acceptance to any Boulder City festival will be jeopardized.

### **Electricity:**

A limited number of spaces have been reserved as electric spaces with one 110 volt outlet. An additional charge of \$60 will be added to your application. If we can not accommodate your request, we will notify you.

### **Nevada Sales Tax:**

You will receive the form "One Time Sales Tax Return" in your April Welcome Packet. You are responsible for the sales tax collected during the Festival. The payment of the taxes collected are due at 4pm on Sunday at the close of the show. They can be paid at the "Information Booth" between 4-6pm. Any vendor who fails to turn in a "One Time Sales Tax Return" will be reported to the Nevada Department of Taxation 10 days after the event closes. **All taxes paid must be in cash. NO CHECKS ACCEPTED FOR TAXES-NO EXCEPTIONS.** Those exhibitors with valid Nevada State Tax numbers simply need to print their number on the form, sign it and turn it into the Show Volunteers at the Information Booth at 4pm on Sunday.

### **Social Media-Online Marketing:**
